

The Creed

Verse: Look upon me and have mercy on me.

How terrible is Your judgement, O Lord, when the angels surround men to herd them before You, and the books are opened, and deeds are exposed, and all thoughts are examined. What judgement will I receive: I am trapped in sins? Who shall quench the flame for me? Who shall enlighten my darkness, if not You, O Lord, who shows mercy to me because of Your love towards mankind?

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit

Grant me tears, O God, as once You granted the adulterous woman. And make me worthy to wash Your feet which delivered me from the way of error, and to offer to You a fragrant ointment, a pure life, bought with my repentance. And so, I shall hear Your voice saying: "Your faith has saved you, go in peace."

Psalm 50

Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. For I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against You, you only, have I sinned, And done this evil in Your sight That You may be found just when You speak, And blameless when You judge.

Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin my mother conceived me. Behold, you desire truth in the inward parts, and in the hidden part You will make me to know wisdom. Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; Wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Make me hear joy and gladness, That the bones You have broken may rejoice. Hide Your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquities.

Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. My enemies reproach me all day long; Those who deride me swear an oath against me. For I have eaten ashes like bread, and mingled my drink with weeping, Because of Your indignation and Your wrath; For You have lifted me up and cast me away. My days are like a shadow that lengthens, and I wither away like grass. But You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations. You will arise and have mercy on Zion; For the time to favour her, yes, the set time, has come. For Your servants take pleasure in her stones and show favour to her dust. So, the nations shall fear the name of the Lord, and all the kings of the earth Your glory. For the Lord shall build up Zion; He shall appear in His glory. He shall regard the prayer of the destitute and shall not despise their prayer. This will be written for the generation to come, that a people yet to be created may praise the Lord. For He looked down from the height of His sanctuary; From heaven the Lord viewed the earth, to hear the groaning of the prisoner, to release those appointed to death, To declare the name of the Lord in Zion, And His praise in Jerusalem, When the peoples are gathered together, And the kingdoms, to serve the Lord. He weakened my strength in the way; He shortened my days. I said, "O my God, do not take me away in the midst of my days; Your years are throughout all generations. Of old You laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands. They will perish, but You will endure; Yes, they will all grow old like a garment; Like a cloak You will change them, and they will be changed. But You are the same, and Your years will have no end. The children of Your servants will continue, and their descendants will be established before You."

The Prayer of Manasseh, King Of Judah

Priest: O Lord Almighty, God of our fathers, of Abraham, of Isaac and of Jacob, and their righteous seed; Who made heaven and earth, with all the firmament thereof; Who bound the sea by the word of Your commandment; Who shut up the deep and sealed it with Your terrible and glorious Name; Whom all creatures fear, and before Whose power they tremble; for the majesty of Your glory cannot be borne and the anger of Your threatening toward sinners is intolerable; and Your merciful promise is immeasurable and unsearchable; for You are the Lord most high, of great compassion, long-suffering, rich in mercy, and You grieve over the evils of men. You, O Lord, according to the multitude of Your loving-kindness, have promised repentance and forgiveness to those that have sinned against You; and of Your infinite mercies have appointed repentance to sinners, that they may be saved. You, therefore, the Lord God of Hosts, have not appointed repentance to the just, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, who have not sinned against You; but You have appointed repentance to me a sinner: for my sins are more in number than the sands of the sea. My transgressions, O Lord, are multiplied, my transgressions are multiplied, and I am not worthy to behold and see the height of heaven because of the multitude of my iniquities. I am bowed down with many iron bands, so that I cannot lift up my head by reason of my sins, neither have I any respite for I have provoked Your wrath and done what is evil in Your sight. I have not done Your will, neither have I kept Your commandments.

I have sinned, O Lord, I have sinned, and I acknowledge my iniquities; but I humbly beseech You, forgive me, O Lord, forgive me, and do not destroy me with my iniquities. Do not be angry with me forever, by reserving my evils for me; neither condemn me to the lower parts of the earth. For You, O God, are the God of those who repent; and in me You will show all Your goodness; and You will save me, unworthy though I be, because of Your great mercy; and I will praise You henceforth all the days of my life. For all the hosts of Heaven sing Your praise, and Yours is the glory to the ages of ages.

Then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains, let those who are in the midst of her depart, and let not those who are in the country enter her. For these are the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people. And they will fall by the edge of the sword and be led away captive into all nations. And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled. And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring; men's hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are coming on the earth, for the powers of the heavens

will be shaken." Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near". Then He spoke to them a parable: "Look at the fig tree, and all the trees. When they are already budding, you see and know for yourselves that summer is now near. So, you also, when you see these things happening, know that the kingdom of God is near.
